- 3) Attach 4 recent identical passport size photographs (Front pose with light background only)
- 4) Appropriate PIO Card fee (US \$ 368.00 or Col Pesos 993,000/- for adult; US \$ 188.00 or Col Pesos 507,600/- for children below the age of 18 year) should be deposited along with the application. The fee should be paid by bank transfer/deposit to Embassy of India Account. **PERSONAL CHEQUES/CREDIT CARDS NOT ACCEPTED.**

- 5) **Enclose old Indian passport and photocopy of first two pages & last two pages or copy of cancelled Indian passport and Colombian/Ecuadorian/Costa Rican passport in original, Photocopy of birth certificate in case of applicants under 18 years along with PIO Card application.**
- 6) **Photocopies of both parent's passport are required in case applicant never held Indian nationality. In case of requirement the original passports requested should be produced.**
- 7) Photocopy of 2 documents as a proof of current address (for example: Driver's License/Telephone bill/Utility bill/lease agreement etc.)
- 8) The processing time for PIO Card application is 15 business days from the date of receipt at the Embassy.
- 9) NOTE: Furnishing of false information will result in summary rejection of the application. Acceptance of application does not confer any right on the applicant to the PIO Card.
